

GREEK WINE

Fun to say, fun to drink.

Greek winemaking has seen a renaissance in recent years. With a focus on quality and the revival of indigenous grape varieties, a new era in Greek wine is upon us. Greek whites tend to show a minerality that tastes like your first swim in the ocean—think salty-ocean-dirty martini in a glass. Though you can't categorise the reds into a style, we have carefully chosen two options that are clean, refreshing, and tend to go with long Mediterranean-style dinners.

2022 Argyros Atlantis Assyrtiko white blend, Santorini [as-syr-tiko]

Assyrtiko Old vines, up to 60-70 years old grown in the traditional kouloura basket training system of Santorini. All the classic volcanic soil characters on show here. Salty, mineral, flinty, citrus-inflected, powerful and long. An explosive finish. Coming from one of the largest family grape owners in Santorini, Mathew Argyros is the current 4th generation winemaker in the family.

2022 Papagiannakos Savatiano 'Old Vine', Attica [sah-vah-tiano]

Savatiano is the most widely planted grape variety in Greece. Has for many decades only been associated with retsina production and cheap volume wines. Papagiannakos has been one of the most important producers in elevating the status of this variety and its ability to make quality wine in Greece. It has an Incredible ability to age. This comes from one of the warmest parts of Greece, just south of Athens. Floral, citrus, white peach, chamomile flowers with a wonderful texture and waxiness to go with freshness. It has an incredible ability to age. Think of this as Greece's answer to Chenin Blanc. This wine is incredibly gastronomic and food-friendly.

2022 Thymiopoulos Rose de Xinomavro, Noussa [zee-no-mav-row]

Coming from the king of Xinomavro - Apostolos Thymiopoulos. This version of Xinomavro is made in a serious rosé mould. Skin contact for 8 hours brings a luminescent salmon orange colour to this wine, filled with complexity and savouriness. Think faded cherries, pomegranate, liquorice with a mouthwatering acidity and saline notes to finish.

2022 Gaia Notios (Agiorgitiko/Syrah), Peloponnese [aye-yor-yee-tee-ko]

A contemporary blend of one of Greece's most important grape varieties grown in the Peloponnese. This is then fleshed out with Syrah. Agi brings juicy red fruits, violet perfume, and a savoury tannin profile, almost akin to tempranillo, with the Syrah fleshing out the wine and adding spice notes.

2021 Thymiopolous 'Young Vines' Xinomavro, Noussa [zee-no-mav-row]

Apostolos has transformed the region in the North of Greece with his ability to bring Xinomavro to the world in a very contemporary, well-made fashion bursting with energy and fruit. There is always a succulence of fruit with his wines, buoyancy, and freshness. The similarities of this variety to Nebbiolo are quite incredible. Poached strawberries, fennel, a light lick of earthiness, with fresh acidity and a noticeable tannin profile from this variety.
